

There are many advantages to raising beef cattle:

- 1. Beef cattle eat roughages. Roughages can be grasses and legume plants.
- 2. Other livestock cannot digest roughages.
- 3. While beef cattle are good foragers, they do not necessarily need to be fed daily. Therefore, labor requirements are not as high with beef cattle as with other livestock.
- 4. If a producer follows good management practices, typically death losses are reasonably low in beef cattle production.
- 5. Beef cattle can be raised in small numbers or by several thousand head. Beef cattle can adapt to different sizes of operations.
- 6. Meat is constantly in demand. Beef and beef products are popular nationally and internationally.
- 7. The beef industry provides many jobs, such as herders, truckers, processors, researchers, veterinarians, and feed suppliers.
- 8. Beef cattle provide an interest to FFA and 4-H projects. Beef cattle can also provide an interest to older adults as an investment.
